Objective test questions differ from subjective test questions, which have more than one potential correct answer and sometimes have room for a justified opinion.

According to Farrugia et al. , an effective research question should "specify the population of interest, be of interest to the scientific community and potentially to the public, have clinical relevance and further current knowledge in the field" and be compliant with current ethical standards (Farrugia et al. 2010).
